

Adult Confirmation

Receive the Holy Spirit



The Adult Confirmation Program is for adults who were baptized and raised Catholic and have received First Holy Communion,

but were not confirmed. Summer is a great time for college students who are home for the Summer to go through Saint Ambrose Confirmation classes. Confirmation enriches the baptized with the strength of the Holy Spirit so that they can be better witness to Christ in word and deed (Catechism of the Catholic Church [CCC] 1285). Anointed by the Holy Spirit at Confirmation, Christians strengthen their bond with the Church and become better equipped to carry out the Church's mission of love and service.

The Adult Confirmation Program is suggested for Saint Ambrose parishioners who:

- Need the Sacrament of Confirmation
- Were baptized Catholic (a copy of the baptism certificate is required if baptized in a different parish)
- Have received First Holy Communion

The length of preparation and formation is dependent upon the catechetical needs of the individual. A retreat and sacramental preparation sessions are scheduled throughout the year. Adults baptized in another Christian denomination who are seeking to become Catholic are properly referred to as candidates for full communion and should read information regarding the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA).
