



## Pilgrims Return: A BEAUTIFUL JOURNEY

The sun was shining almost as bright as the spirits of the parishioners who made pilgrimage to the Basilica of the Assumption in Covington, KY and the Cathedral of Saint Peter and Saint Francis Xavier parish in Cincinnati.

Not only were we able to visit these breathtaking monuments to God's goodness and mercy, but we were also able to learn how people, in spite of great challenges, gave everything for Jesus and left us testimonies of the Faith in stained glass and marble. The pilgrims returned to Saint Ambrose with hearts full of thankfulness, praise and zeal to spread the truth of Christ's message and the healing of God's mercy to all.

## Community Day: MANY HANDS MADE LIGHT WORK

On April 29, for our 3rd Annual Community Day, almost 500 of our members came together to truly be the hands of the Lord!

While the weather was a bit dreary and rainy, everyone had a smile on their face and a generous and helpful hand ready and willing to work! We worked on over 50 projects in the community, at our parishioner's homes, and here on Saint Ambrose campus - we raked, mulched, cleared out gardens and flower beds, painted, cut trees and bushes and branches... everyone coming together to be the hands of the Lord for those in need.

We had hundreds of volunteers that worked tirelessly with giving, generous hearts to serve those as God serves us. Everyone that we helped was beyond words at how appreciative they were! They truly felt the care and love that all of our volunteers gave to them. Not only are their yards and grounds beautiful, clean and safe... God's love and care was brought into their homes and into their hearts!

## Together we are...GREATER THAN HEROIN!

Over the past year, through The FEST, we have been building a coalition throughout the region to raise awareness, start a conversation and provide resources to Faith Leaders.

The weekend after Easter, over 450 Churches of every denomination spoke, preached, prayed, mentioned or talked about the heroin crisis in their service, many also included information about the Greater Than Heroin website ([www.GreaterThanHeroin.com](http://www.GreaterThanHeroin.com)) in their bulletin.

Following this 'Awareness Sunday', over 33,000 lbs of prescription medication was turned into local law enforcement agencies on Drug Take Back Day, a 5,000 lb increase over the previous year. In early May, we also hosted a Faith Leaders training luncheon in which we had over 100 Faith Leaders join us to learn more about the epidemic and what they specifically can do in their congregations. It was wonderful to see so many people of different faiths, ages, backgrounds and races coming together for the common good.

Everyone can do something to help address this issue: talk about it with your children (no matter how old or young they are). If you know someone with an addiction, help them seek the help they need. Properly dispose of any unused medications, especially prescription pain killers. 3 out of 4 heroin addicts were first addicted to pain medicine.

Get involved - Saint Ambrose is looking to grow an addiction ministry. If you're interested in being involved, contact the Parish Office.

## City-Wide Healing Service: AN EVENING OF FAITH & LOVE

**No matter what Jesus is doing in your life, He wants to give you more of His Spirit," said Fr. Mathias. "The key is learning there is more, asking for it, and receiving it. There is more—and it's for those who believe and those who ask."**

Encounter Ministries and Saint Ambrose Church partnered to put on the Cleveland City-Wide Healing Service on May 20. **Father Mathias Thelen from Detroit, Michigan led the service that approximately 750 people attended.** Many of these individuals traveled great distances in hopes for healing, and no one was disappointed. People witnessed individuals healed spiritually, who had doubted their faith or Jesus' love, only to truly witness His love after being prayed over by the Healing Ministry team. There was also physical healing for individuals with back, neck or rheumatoid arthritis. People, who had not been able to walk stairs in quite some time, were able to walk the steps to the altar. **Everyone in the Church could feel the Holy Spirit in the air and were encouraged as they sensed God's love.**

*"Thank you for letting me be a part of the phenomenal evening of faith and love. You could feel the Holy Spirit's presence!"*

*"Last night was a totally amazing experience for me. I felt a little sad leaving at 10:30 but honestly, I was so filled up inside with the Spirit....slept so well that I almost missed 7:30 Mass. For me, I am learning and experiencing so much with Jesus. What He can do through me and listening as He talks me through it. I think I have somehow always known this. But, last night opened one door for more."*

**In the middle of June, 65 missionaries will head to our mission communities in the Dominican Republic.** Over the course of two weeks (two groups each going for one week), we will continue to work to build a better world for those in need following the vision and spirit of Jesus Christ.

**The theme for these mission weeks is "Somos el cuerpo de Cristo" - "We are the Body of Christ".** It comes from the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (June 18). It reminds us that - together - we are sisters and brothers - together - we form one Body in Christ. All of us are important and essential in the building up of the Kingdom of God.

### IN OUR NAME, THESE MISSION TEAMS WILL:

- ...Feed the hungry with food (rice and beans)
- ...Feed the Spiritual hungers (Vacation Bible School for the children)
- ...Stir a different vision of cooperation as we work side by side with our mission family
- ...Complete a special place for the entire community to come together as one - a baseball field.
- ...Build five new homes (and move families into their homes) to create a safe and caring place for each family.
- ...Bring the Light to break the darkness by installing two donated solar panels which will provide light in the night (they often are without electricity for half of the day/night).

Mostly, we will build up the Body of Christ as we bring hope that they are not alone and that - together - we can help each other find a better way ... a path to a fuller life in Christ.


