Community Day: THANK YOU!

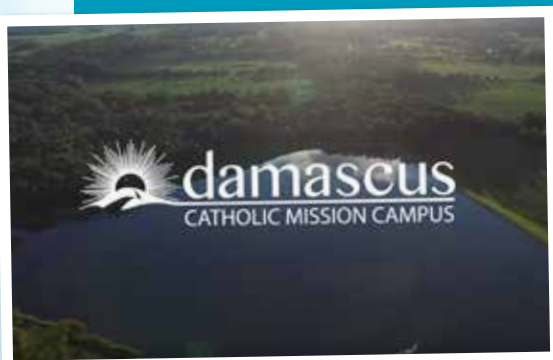
What a phenomenal day we had...so many of our members came together to truly be the hands of the Lord!

Small Change – Big Difference

God bless the hundreds of you who used your Lent Rice Bowl. Together - we raised almost \$8,000 – almost enough for a new home...your Lenten sacrifice will create new life for a family in our mission community. God bless you.

It seems like a small thing, but in early May I had the blessing of spending three days in our mission community.

My primary mission was to join in the dedication of a septic system. We take sanitation for granted in our country. For the past four years, we have advocated relentlessly to the government to build a septic plant to take care of the homes in our community. As part of the dedication, Bishop Nicanor expressed his deep thanks to our parish for the great work we are doing to help some of the poorest of the poor in his country. The dedication ceremony had every television station in the Dominican present, along with over 150 people. It may seem like a small thing to us – but clean water and sanitation – makes a big difference to those we serve.

Thanks, again, to your generosity and goodness, we are working to finish six homes during our June mission trip.

These 440 sq. ft. houses will be a safe and comfortable home for a family of five or six. Watch for pics during the middle of June as new families move into these houses.

Please keep the mission teams in your prayers as they work to care for the needy in mid-June. Together - we are working to build a better world for all of God's people. You make the mission possible!!
