...Martha, burdened with much serving, came to him and said, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me." The Lord said to her in reply, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her." This familiar Gospel passage offers a good reflection for the second half of July. How are we taking some time to 'rest' and 'be present' with the Lord so that God can nourish, strengthen and renew us? We need to do 'the work' of Mary, and we also need to follow the wisdom of Martha. Martha is more than laying in the sun or taking a vacation. **Martha's wisdom is to consciously 'sit' with the Lord ... in prayer... in reflection....at the Table of the Lord.**

...I had a wonderful conversation this week with a nineteen year old college student. He was registering with the parish. He went off to college last fall and, while there, was introduced by one of our members to the Lord. **As he shared his story, he spends time throughout the week, after work, in the chapel talking to the Lord** and working things out in his mind and heart. He was 'surprised' that more people didn't stop by the chapel. He went on to talk about the blessings he has found in this new friendship. He registered with the parish because he really wants to 'belong' to a community – a family – and has come to love Saint Ambrose. What a blessing.

...The chapel has been renewed over the past few months. **Take a minute to stop by for some 'Martha' time** – sitting quietly and peacefully with the Lord. It's comfortable... peaceful...a place to allow the Lord to refresh and renew you.

...We are working on adding Stations to the chapel. As you may recall, we were blessed to obtain beautiful mosaic images of the journey of Christ from the Ursuline Motherhouse. They really fit the space beautifully and will greatly enrich the chapel as a place of prayer and reflection.

We literally 'cut' the stations out of the walls. The company that did the beautiful work in the Church is cleaning them up and will frame and mount them in the chapel. **We are looking for 14 people/families who can help us with this project.** Please consider a Station in memory of a loved one, or as a special gift to the Lord and our community. **We are asking a donation to the Building Fund of \$2500.** A memorial plaque will also be prepared. There's a picture in today's bulletin, and a sample can be seen in the chapel. If you are interested, or want to learn more, please let me know (frbob@StAmbrose.us).

...We met with Marous Brothers to start the final 'wrap up' on the Church project. **Many have been asking about railings for the front stairs. They are coming....soon and very soon.** All the contractors are busy....so we are waiting patiently like Martha! Watch for details.

...A few weeks ago I introduced the 'cool kid club' as a gentle way of saying that **all of us should try to use the ramps and rails in both the sanctuary and entry ways.** If we all use ramps and rails, it will make it more comfortable for all. Some need them...some will just be 'cool'.

...Over the next several weeks we are hopeful that we will receive permission to begin working on the **Catholic Works of Mercy Outreach Center.** The funds for this project were designated by the donors to create a 2,400 sq. ft. pole barn facility that will help us support the amazing care and outreach our community gives to so many of our brothers and sisters. We are working with many of our members who are in the trades to secure donations that will allow us to make the most of this opportunity to create this building. **Watch for details coming soon.**

...Speaking of our Catholic Works of Mercy Outreach, **our food pantry is now certified by the Akron Food Bank.** This means we can access fresh meat to distribute to those in need. This is in addition to fresh vegetables coming soon from our community garden (and so many of yours). Last week we cared for 34 families at the weekly food distribution. What a blessing!!

...The Christmas trees remind us of **Christmas in July** and our efforts to take care of the students in the City of Cleveland at Saint Rocco School and Thomas Jefferson Newcomer Academy. **Please grab a tag, or simply get some new school supplies and drop them off next week at Mass.** Together we can extend the care and compassion of Christ to these young students as they prepare to start the new school year.

...Speaking of the new school year...**this is a GREAT week to sign up for PSR.** Even better, remind your neighbors and friends. PSR helps pass on the teachings of Christ and the values of our faith to our students.

...Many thanks to all who responded to **The FEST** invitation last weekend. A good number of our members signed up to volunteer. Many purchased FEST raffle tickets for a chance to win great prizes and even more...to keep The FEST FREE and open to everyone. 

Catholic Charities Counseling Schedule An Appointment Today




