

# Virtual Ministry & Meeting Platforms

- **Google Duo**
  - Video call app for smartphones, tablets, and computers for up to 12 people
  - Available for download (free) on Android and iOS systems
  - For tablets & mobile devices, head to your app store and download the Google Duo app to get started
  - For computers, head to [duo.google.com](https://duo.google.com) to get started
- **Skype (Video and/or Audio call, chat features)**
  - For an audio call or a video call, up to 50 people can be on the same call
  - From a computer, head to [www.skype.com](https://www.skype.com) to get started and create a free account
  - From a mobile device (iPhone only), head to the app store and download “Skype for iPhone” to get started and create your free account
- **Zoom (Video and/or Audio call, chat features, screen share ability)**
  - The meeting facilitator will need to head to [www.zoom.us](https://www.zoom.us) to create a free account
  - Meeting facilitator can create a meeting and send out the link and instructions to participants
  - Meetings can last up to 40 minutes with the free account, up to 100 people
  - Participants can join via computer or mobile device
  - To join from a mobile device, first head to the app store and download the Zoom app and create a free account and log in
- **Google Hangout (Video and/or Audio call, chat features, screen share ability)**
  - Up to 15 people can participate
  - Meeting facilitator needs to log in to their google account and head to [hangouts.google.com](https://hangouts.google.com) to set up a video or phone call and send an invitation to participants
  - Participants can join via computer or with the Google Hangouts app on their mobile device
