PARISH NEWS • Letter from our Pastor

...“I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly.” At Saint Ambrose we say - over and over - that Jesus Christ is everything for us. He is our Light, our Hope, our Strength for the Journey. He is the way, the truth and our life. He is the living water, the fount of mercy, and our hope eternal. Today, He is our gate. On this Good Shepherd Sunday, He is both the Shepherd of the flock and the Gate to the eternal pasture. The Gate is a powerful reflection because it means both the door way is clear, the path is outlined, and eternal life is possible. It also means that we have pass through the Gate which means listening so closely to the call of the Shepherd and walking in His ways. **Every time you pass through a doorway or gate this week, pray that you can pass through the Gate that leads to Heaven.**

...This is Good Shepherd Sunday. **Last Sunday Bishop Malesic, the shepherd for our local church, was at Saint Ambrose for Confirmation.** They were beautiful celebrations. He commented on the ‘joyfulness’ of our prayer and worship. He could feel so much ‘joy’ in our community. **God bless our newly confirmed. Over and over again, he called them the ‘young church’ and echoed how much we need the ‘young church’ to help all of us renew and strengthen our Church.**

He will be coming out this Wednesday, May 3 for a visit, tour and lunch with our parish team. **We will also be the host parish for Nathan Frankart** from Saint Mary Seminary. Nathan will spend next school year with us at Saint Ambrose. He will be in his third year of priestly formation. **Their help will be greatly appreciated as Father Andrew and I continue to also extend pastoral care and sacramental help to Saint Colette after the passing of Father Krizner.**

...Our parish has also been blessed to serve as a field ed parish for those preparing for the Diaconate. **Michael Mucic** (who has been at Saint Ambrose this school year) and **Bill Elwer** (who served last year) **are both being ordained to the Diaconate this weekend.** Please keep them and their families in your prayers. Hopefully, we will have them back at Saint Ambrose soon to celebrate with them.

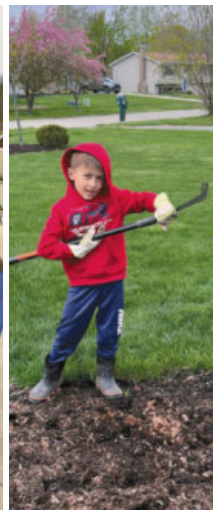
Community Service Weekend

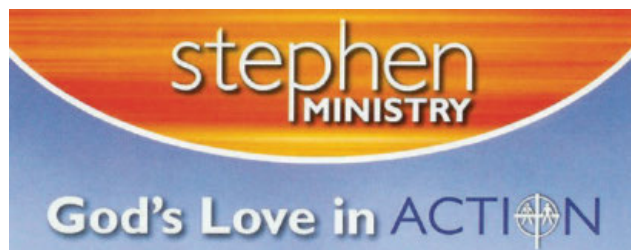

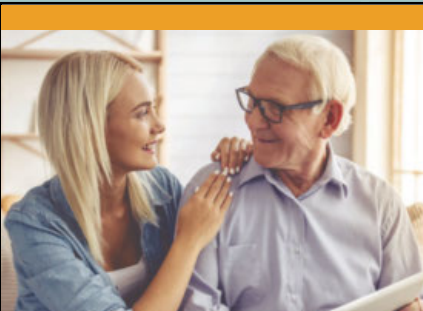

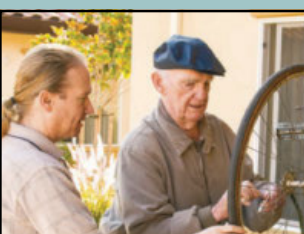
