- ..."Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" So they set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them who were saying, "The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon!" Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of bread." The Gospel on this Third Sunday of Easter is the well-known story of the Journey to Emmaus. It is a rich story that offers each of us an opportunity for reflection. Every day it is the Lord who walks with us. Do we allow ourselves the time and vision to see the presence of God with us on the journey? The Emmaus story also reminds us of the power of journeying together. Jesus never sent them out on the journey alone. Who walks with you on our faith journey? Who do you walk with to help **them journey with the Lord?** The early disciples 'recounted' the stories of God working in their lives. What are your God **stories?** Do you share them with others to inspire their faith? All good questions for us to reflect on in this Easter Season.
- ...This is the day the Lord has made... let us rejoice and be glad!!! When we live in the awareness of God with us on the journey, our hearts should be filled with joy!!! When we take the time to gather at the Table of the Lord, where we break the bread in remembrance of Jesus, we should be filled with joy. When we gather at the Table of the Lord, we can best have the clarity of seeing God and understanding God's will in our lives.
