Liturgy Corner

We Give Thanks with Grateful Hearts

If you have ever attended an Easter Vigil Mass, you have experienced the highlight of the

Liturgical Year. From the beautifully moving Service of Light to the initiation of the R.C.I.A. candidates, it is a unique time in the Church. This includes the blessing of the Paschal candle. The Paschal candle can be found near the baptismal font in the Sanctuary of the church, it is lit during the Easter season, during baptisms, and funerals.

Though a new Paschal candle is used each year, there are similarities between them. Four symbols can be seen on the candle: a cross, the symbols for the Greek letters "Alpha" and "Omega," the year it is used, and five grains of incense representing the five wounds of Christ. During baptisms, it is a reminder of the Holy Spirit and the fire that John the Baptist promised to us through baptism. A smaller candle is lit from the Paschal candle and given to the parents as a



lasting reminder of our call to spread the light of Christ and the hope of the resurrection. The newly baptized is also given a Baptismal Blanket made by our Prayer Shawl ministry, where they are praying for the child and the RCIA candidates (as they crochet) who will be receiving the blanket at the Sacrament of Baptism.




