## **PARISH NEWS** • Letter from our Pastor

...Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." The work is not done. There is more to do!!! This weekend we return to Ordinary Time (having completed the Easter Season). There's nothing Ordinary about the faithful love of God. Even more, there is nothing ordinary about the work that God entrusts to our care. We ask God to call forth more 'laborers' for the work of the Lord. While that certainly includes praying for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life, it also means that each of us – every day – need to be open to the 'call' of thé Lord. He calls us to do the work of building His Kingdom and

strengthen the bonds of our community of faith.

...This weekend we are blessed to welcome and meet Father Dan Samide. He comes to



us from his first priestly assignment at Saint Anthony of Padua in Parma. A long time ago, Father Samide was at Saint Ambrose for his seminary field ed. It's great to have him join us. God bless Father Andrew who helped him settle in while I was in our mission.

...This is a big week for our parish community. In addition to welcoming Father Dan, we kick off our summer festival this Thursday thru Sunday night. Over the years, it has truly become a great community celebration. It's also a great chance for so many of us to work together for the glory of God and the good of our community. To the Gospel, the work is abundant, we still need some more laborers (volunteers) to help for a few hours. ...Many thanks to all who have already turned in their festival raffle tickets. YOU can win the best prizes and we can help support our parish community especially as we work to address some summer capital repairs (tuck pointing the buildings, sealing the brick on the exterior of the Church, resurfacing the south parking lot, and some annual concrete work). ...We are so blessed with a strong, active, vibrant Women's Guild. They have great fun and do such good work for our parish community. Last week they made a donation to our parish community which will help us replace some warmer ovens in Hilkert Hall (that all can use throughout the year), along with getting a Baptismal Font for the Chapel (to help us keep up with the 160 Baptism we are doing each year). **God bless the Guild.** 

....This past week I spent three days with our mission team in the **Dominican Republic.** They will return home on Sunday. They supported a three-day health clinic to take care of those who live on the outskirts of town and have very limited access to care. We also worked to complete five new homes and start the process of getting them painted and families moved in. The group installed two new sets of swings for the kids (which were so well received). When the group comes home, they will tell you how good it was to be back together in the mission doing the work of building up God's Kingdom... especially among the poorest of the poor.

...There are many wonderful stories from the mission trip. **One silly story that speaks volumes to the mission of the Church comes from Bob.** Bob is in his mid-60's. This is his first mission trip. When he saw all the kids, he taught them how to make 'horseshoes' out of tree branches and play horseshoes. They loved it. **It was also a clear reminder that everyone of us has something wonderful to give, share and offer for the glory of God and the building up of the Body of Christ, the Church!!** 

...This coming Tuesday we need many hands to sort lots of canned food items for distribution to 425 families in Cleveland on Wednesday. If one of your gifts is to sort cans, we would love to have you at 4 pm in Hilkert Hall. It's one more way that we can continue the mission of Jesus and caring for those in need.

...Another great example of 'hearing the call' to build up the Kingdom was last Sunday night. We had our Parish Council Leadership Team meeting. We've welcomed some new members onto the PPC Leadership Group and they were doing great work helping strengthen our PPC and do some 'strategic thinking' for the good of our parish community. As you are seeing in the bulletin, we are doing a better job of communicating the important work the PPC does to help our parish respond to the spiritual and pastoral needs of our members. ## Liturgy Corner Ordinary Time

The season of Ordinary Time has two parts, but it remains one season. The first part begins right after the feast of the Epiphany and runs until Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday. The second part begins the Monday after Pentecost and runs until the First Sunday of Advent. **We are currently in the second part of Ordinary Time.** 

The term 'ordinary' in our common use typically refers to something being plain, unimpressive, or unexciting. Many people hear 'Ordinary Time' and they immediately think of the season as such.

Ordinary Time contains the rest of Jesus' earthly ministry and some of the major events of the Gospels we have come to know and love. *This is the time of conversion, a time for us to deepen our relationship with God - living the life of Christ.* And just like any other season in the liturgical calendar, this season celebrates a very specific time in the life of our Lord, Jesus Christ. The miracles, the parables, the calling of the twelve, the sermon on the mount, the messages about the bread of life...we get all that and more during this season. Truly, there is much to celebrate.
