PARISH NEWS • Letter from our Pastor

...“Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, “LORD.” Thus the LORD passed before him and cried out, “The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.” Moses at once bowed down to the ground in worship.”

The first reading on this Feast of the Holy Trinity is from the Book of Exodus. The reading is profound in that we receive God’s name (Lord) and learn about the qualities of the Lord. The Lord is merciful, gracious, slow to anger, rich in kindness and fidelity. **What a blessing that our God – our Lord – is so kind and merciful to us.** Let’s be honest, all of us depend on these qualities of God. And on this Feast of the Holy Trinity, when we celebrate our being a trinity of persons (Father, Son and Spirit), we are going to be best in building the unity of persons if we are kind, merciful and gracious to others.

...Every day we can call out to the Lord, by name. Take some time to stop in the Chapel, reflect on the image of the Christ of Mercy, and use it as a moment to see how the Lord is inviting you to embrace the mercy and compassion that the Lord has for you.

...The Trinity sets the model of the Church – many persons united and bound together in the love of God. **The Church is always best when we follow the pattern given to us by the Trinity.** The Celtic Trinity is above the entryways of the Church and over the Holy Water Fonts to remind us over and over again that we are called to be many persons united by the love of God. We are best when we come together as one united in the Lord.

...Next weekend, as we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, we are inviting and asking all of our members to commit to 30 minutes of prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. As we center our lives on Christ, we will find the mercy, compassion, and faithful love of God in our lives. **We are asking everyone to find an extra 30 minutes of time from Saturday at 5:30 pm to Monday at 7:30 pm to come together in prayer for our country, for our families, for our own good and, mostly, for the glory and honor of God.** The more fervent and faithful we are in prayer, the more we will find the grace, wisdom and strength of the Lord in our lives. This will be a blessed way for us to come together united in the love of God and committed fervently in prayer for the glory of God and for the good of our families and community.

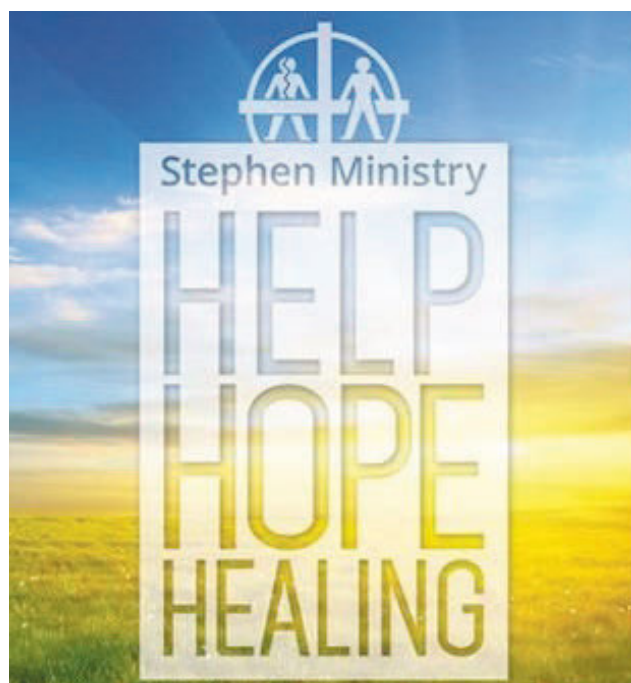
"Love One Another as I Have Loved You..."

Liturgy Corner

Sacrament of Reconciliation

This coming **Wednesday, June 7, at 4:30 pm** is our monthly Reconciliation. The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession, Penance) is the means and the sign that Christ gave us to show His willingness to heal us when turn away from Him. Many times, because of fear, shame, or influences of the world telling us that we don't need God, or our thinking of "my daily prayers, sacrifices, and works of charity make up for my sins", gives us a reason not to go.

It can be quite normal to feel anxious or nervous about receiving this Sacrament. When we do not go to Confession, we miss the importance of this sacrament that is so beautiful and so full of mercy. God calls us, not to condemn but to save us, through:

1. **Repentance** - to humbly and honestly recognize our sins and failures;
2. **Contrition** - to be really sorry for hurting God and others;
3. **Penance** - to outwardly show in our thoughts, words, and actions our 'yes' to God and our 'no' to evil;
4. **Absolution** - in this sacrament, our sins are forgiven by God through Jesus in the ministry of the priest, and therefore, we are once more reconciled with God and one another, the Church.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation opens the doors to participate in the Mass and receive the Eucharist leading us into the holiness and grace that God wants to give us.
