Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf." This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi - the Body and Blood of Christ. It gives us an opportunity to reflect on the blessing of the Eucharist in the life of our Church. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. We come to the Table of the Lord to be nourished and strengthened by the Lord so that we can go forth and be a Eucharistic people - so that we can be the Living Body of Christ. ## Liturgy Corner Body and Blood of Christ

The Pelican is one of the first symbols for the Lord's Supper. The pelican in her faithfulness, is depicted on the Louisiana state flag, and this image is present on altars and in the sanctuaries of many Catholic churches in the state. According to tradition, during times of extreme drought and deprivation, the mother pelican pierces her breast in order to feed her young with her own blood, rather than let them starve. As you can see, the sculpture from a column (located in the Upper Room) depicts two baby pelicans doing just that. This image served early Christians as a metaphor for the One who gave His Body for us (1 Corinthians 11:2325). Christians adopted the pelican as a representation of the Savior, Jesus Christ, who shed his blood for all.

Jesus continues to feed us, His children, with His Body and Blood in the Eucharist. This selfless gesture, instituted on Holy Thursday, is the pinnacle of our Catholic faith. We feed on His Body and Blood and are given life-giving spiritual food to sustain and strengthen us on our daily journeys. The Eucharist is the answer for a world troubled by war, violence, pride, and a lack of focus on God.
