PARISH NEWS • Letter from our Pastor

... "A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell on the path, and birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had little soil. It sprang up at once because the soil was not deep, and when the sun rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of roots. Some seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold. Whoever has ears ought to hear." Today's Gospel is very familiar and one we can easily relate to. Why don't all the seeds come up and produce fruit?? It all depends on the soil conditions and the way we care and nurture them. The same is true with the seeds of faith...the seeds of God Word...the seeds of God's love. Learn a lesson from nature. Our hearts need tilled. We need to 'pull the weeds.' And, we need to continue to nurture, water, and care for each day. May our hearts be open to the seeds of faith, God's love - God's Word - and take root in our hearts today.



- Families up to 450% of the Federal poverty level receive a full scholarship.
- All other households receive partial scholarships on a sliding scale, with the lowest being 10% of a full scholarship.
- Scholarship amounts are determined by adjusted gross income and household size.
