PARISH NEWS • Letter from our Pastor

... "Thus says the LORD: Observe what is right, do what is just; for my salvation is about to come, my justice, about to be revealed." The prophet Isaiah, thousands of years ago, proclaimed this message. "Observe what is right, do what is just." It's that simple. Another way of saying it, "Love God and Love your neighbor." Can you imagine how wonderful and blessed our world would be if we simply observe what is right and do what is just??? We will be bold proclaimers of the justice and mercy of God. It's the mercy and justice of God that we count on (reflect on the Psalm) and it's that same mercy and justice we should share with others.

"Every Church should be able to get a letter of recommendation from the poor in their community." (Bishop Desmond Tutu). I saw this on Facebook today (Tuesday) and it caused me to reflect on this day in the life of our parish. This morning started with a team of our members meeting the Akron Food Bank Truck around 7 am followed by more folk arriving to sort and prepare for food distribution to a line of cars wrapping around our campus by 9 am. Later in the day, a whole other group came in at 3 pm to set up and start the process of sorting canned food items and prepare bags for 425 families in Cleveland on Wednesday. And, in the middle of the day, Jeff Trush and I connected to discuss some Catholic Works of Mercy business. Last week they took care of 104 families in our Wednesday weekly food distribution with students also receiving school supplies (thanks again to your goodness). And after Mass, Shari Whisler shared with me that all the students in our local community and at Saint Rocco will receive all the school supplies they need (thanks to the Christmas in July trees). And... as I write this bulletin, I cannot thank you enough for all you do so we can care for our sisters and brothers who are in need. Observe what is right. Do what is just!! God bless you.

...It's BACK to School week for so many of our students. Let's pray that God will bless and protect all of our teachers, faculty, staff and students in this new school year. This weekend we offer a special prayer of blessing.

...We are excited to welcome 510 students to Saint Ambrose School (K-8) and 162 littlest angels in our preschool program. **God bless Mrs. Cinadr** who has been leading the charge this summer to help make sure we are ready for an amazing year of learning and growth. **God bless Mr. Tom Krebs** (Assistant Principal) and Mrs. Catherine Mitchell (LAPS Director) for their hard work to make sure we are ready for the opening bell. Liturgy Corner Divine Mercy Chaplet


Our Heavenly Father said to Saint Faustina:

"When this chaplet is said by the bedside of a dying person ... unfathomable mercy envelops the soul, and the very depths of My tender mercy are moved for the sake of the sorrowful Passion of My Son."

The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, obedient to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy.

Divine Mercy is when God's love meets us and helps us in the midst of our suffering and sin. We're all sinners and because suffering is in our lives, God's love for us always takes the form of mercy. It's always the Lord stepping out in compassion to help us, the poor, weak, and broken sinners.

We have a Divine Mercy Prayer Team which the Divine Mercy Chaplet is prayed for those very sick or nearing the end of their lives. Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet can be said on beads like the Rosary or other ways that help you keep count. Additionally, in our Chapel is the image of Jesus' Divine Mercy. Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet in front of the image of Jesus.




