
The Transfiguration of the Lord

In this weekend's Gospel, we hear about a time when Jesus was revealed to His disciples as the Son of God. This important event in the life of Jesus and His disciples is called the Transfiguration, which reaffirmed what the disciples had suspected which is that **Jesus is the Messiah.**

We might also have moments like this in our lives, moments when we are certain about what we believe in. But, like Peter, we may not understand fully what we have experienced until later. The disciples reflected on the Transfiguration after the events of the Lord's Passion and came to understand what had been revealed to them about Jesus on the mountain—that *He is the Son of God who would die and rise for our Salvation*.

Every family has special moments that they remember and share. In sharing these stories, the meaning and importance of the events develop and deepen over time. This is how it was with the disciples' remembrance of Jesus' Transfiguration. As Peter, James, and John reflected on the event and told other believers about the Transfiguration, their own faith deepened.

Gather your family and think about some special memories that your family recalls over and over again. Talk about why these moments are important to you. Talk about your family and the promises you have made to one another, pray together as a family, and continue to grow in faithfulness to each other and to the Lord. The Bible tells us many important stories about Jesus and His teachings. Discuss and share these stories and experience first-hand the wonder of God.






