
Stage 1, Part 1 Begins on September 6


Liturgy Corner

All the Little Children Come to God

We know it can be challenging for families with young children to participate weekly in Mass. There are times when young children or babies can become loud and what some may call disruptive. The Family Room or front vestibule can help in those times of difficult moments. Our priests and deacons are very patient and understanding when this happens. While young children cannot fully understand all that goes on at Mass, there are times within the Mass that they can participate in some ways. They can learn to genuflect and bow; they can place their envelope in the basket; say the Our Father; offer the Sign of Peace. Our Journey with Jesus program is offered in the school for preschool children ages 3-5 years old during 9:00 am and 10:30 am Mass. At our 4:30 pm Mass on Saturday and at the 9:00 am and 10:30 am Masses on Sunday, children in grades 1-3 can look forward to going to the Chapel for Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) where they will hear the scripture readings proclaimed and explained at an age-appropriate level. For those children who love to sing, our Angels and Cherub Choirs sing once a month at the 9:00 am

When we bring our children to Mass, they hear the word of God and pray, praising Him. Those prayers, songs, and phrases expressing the foundations of our faith are repeated week after week and are seeds of faith that will stay with our children forever.


From Nathan Frankart
