## PARISH NEWS · Letter from Our Pastor

- ..."Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus." The second reading, from Paul's letter to the Philippians, ends with this profound and thought-provoking reflection. "Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus." You may recall a phrase, "What would Jesus do?" It's really the right question. Imagine if all of us simply had the same attitude of Christ. We would be kind, accepting, welcoming, loving and caring. We would be generous, prayerful, reflective and service-minded. Ask yourself throughout the week, am I living with the same attitude of Christ Jesus?
- ...This Wednesday we celebrate the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi (October 4). Saint Francis, in his timeless prayer, teaches us what it means to have the attitude of Christ. "Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy."
- ...On the Feast of Saint Francis, we are inviting and challenging all of our members to use this day as a day of prayer working for a more peaceful world - in the attitude of Christ. Throughout the course of the day, all of our Saint Ambrose School students will make a peace pledge. Our PSR students will do the same. Our parish staff will spend the morning in prayer and reflection. The Church will be open all day. There will be Eucharistic Adoration from 9 am until 7:30 pm in the Chapel. All of our parish leaders are invited to an Evening of Reflection at 6:30 pm. The goal of the day is to focus on prayer and action in being instruments of peace in our community and across our world.
- ... A special part of the Feast of Saint Francis and the first Wednesday of the month is the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation Confession. It's a powerful way to experience the outpouring of God's mercy and forgiveness. Several priests will be on hand from 4:30 pm to 6 pm. Every week Confession is available following the evening Mass starting at 6 pm.

- ...Last week the Junior High students of Saint Ambrose School had an XLT – a time of prayer, praise music and Eucharistic Adoration. One of our parents sent this email after her kids came from school,

- "I am overjoyed the 5-8th graders had the opportunity to sit with Jesus today in adoration!!!! It was the FIRST thing both my kids mentioned when I asked how their day was today. My child commented, "mom it was amazing. There was incense and everything." There is something prayerful and powerful that happens when we spend time and 'sit' with the Lord.

## **Liturgy Corner**Miraculous Medial

Miraculous Medal is a gift to us, designed by our Blessed Mother and revealed to Saint Catherine over 200 years ago in France. The symbolism on the front and back of the medal have very deep meaning and it did not originate from an earthly imagination.

The front of the medal features Mary standing on the top of a globe, with her feet crushing the head of a serpent. The words, "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee" encircle her image. This refers to the dogma of Mary's own sinless conception, the Immaculate Conception. The back of the medal shows 12 stars



surrounding a cross with the letter "M" woven to it (the Marian Cross). Two hearts are below the M: one with thorns – the heart of Jesus and the other with a sword piercing it – the heart of Mary. The 12 stars denote the 12 apostles, the cross stands for Christ, the M is for Mary, and the two hearts point to the love of Jesus and Mary for the whole world. Mary told Catherine, "Have a medal struck upon this model. Those who wear it will receive great graces, especially if they wear it around the neck." It became known as the Miraculous Medal only after so many graces and miracles were witnessed with this devotion throughout France.



Saint Ambrose School celebrated International Day of Peace this past week in meaningful ways. K-8 students collaborated on a STEAM Pinwheels for Peace Project. 




