


Liturgy Corner A Presider's Chalice

Many have inquired about Father Dan's beautiful chalice. His chalice have a special meaning, and it is customary for a priest's parents to give him a chalice as an ordination gift.

Here, Father Dan shares his chalice story with us: "Throughout my years in seminary I heard about the men who were about to be ordained going to the Diocesan Archives to pick out a chalice. The Archives, as I understood them, were comprised of items from closed churches, deceased priests, or simply things that fell out of use but still had value. One of the chalices they showed me caught my eye, and I claimed it. While very tarnished at the time, you could still see the twelve apostles depicted – six on the base and six on the cup. My parents paid to have it replated and the results were better that we could have imagined. The chalice is owned by the Ursuline Sisters of Cleveland and is now 110 years old. They archived it with the hope that a newly ordained priest would use it during his ministry. The summer after I was ordained, I brought the chalice to the Ursuline residence and celebrated Mass for the Ursuline community. I will keep the chalice for the rest of my life, and when I die it will go back into the possession of the Ursulines – and hopefully another priest will continue to use it after that! The beauty of our Church is truly timeless!"






