- ..."Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. 
# **Liturgy Corner**Children's Offertory

# From our Parish Pastoral Council



#### You Asked...We Listened.

#### Who Is Parish Council?

We are a consultative body to Father Bob, addressing the pastoral needs of Saint Ambrose Parish. The council is led by Father Bob, with 20 parishioner members, and two Pastoral staff. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday evening of each month.

#### **What Does Parish Council Do?**

In the past year and a half, discussions centered on post COVID pastoral needs. The "Best Idea" initiative and website link resulted from these discussions. Over 150 ideas were submitted by February 2023! "Think Tank" sessions were held in early 2023 where we reviewed the ideas with parish members. A lot of best actions and attitudes observed at Saint Ambrose were also identified during these sessions, and a graphic, (I.C.E) was created to illustrate these best practices.

#### What happened to the Best Ideas?

All 150 Best Ideas were placed into categories such as Community, Family, Youth, Education, Liturgy, etc. Ideas were then prioritized and forwarded for further investigation/action to appropriate parties. 

Catholic Charities accepts credit cards, Medicaid, Medicare, and private insurance. They also offer a sliding fee scale to those who qualify.




#### Donna Bonvissuto, LPC




