...with over **25 volunteers** who passed out over **6,000 community meals** in 2022.

...to be able to respond to **2,400 calls for assistance** with utilities, rent, medical bills and other household expenses.

...to be able to distribute over **2,000 Christmas gifts** from St. Ambrose Kindness Pine Tree.

...with "Christmas in July" **school supply pass out** to almost **400 students**.

...to have parishioners who will donate **over 300 blankets** to help the needy stay warm this winter.

...to have parishioners who will donate over **1,000 turkeys and pies** to help feed the needy this Thanksgiving.

MILITARY MESSAGES MINISTRY



Military Messages Ministry started in November 2022. At Christmas time we filled the giving trees with 800 tags that had the names of all our armed forces so that our parish community could take a tag and pray for them. In less than a year we have sent our active duty armed forces personally written cards and notes for Valentine's Day and Easter. We delivered 30 Easter Lilies to families. We have sent six personalized birthday boxes. We held a summer picnic for all of the families of our active duty members.

Blessed to Feed Thousands

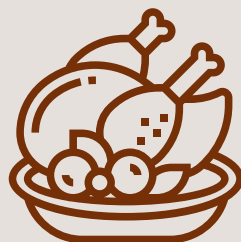
