PARISH NEWS • Letter from Our Pastor

- ..."Then the door was locked. Afterwards the other virgins came and said, 'Lord, Lord, open the door for us!' But he said in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, I do not know you.' Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour." The Gospel this weekend focuses our attention on the 'end times'. This will continue over the next several weeks. It's not meant to scare us but to wake us up. Every day we need to walk faithfully with the Lord our God. We need to make sure we 'know' the Lord and even more, that the Lord knows us. We need to 'wake up' and be attentive to our life of faith - our relationship with the Lord.
