- We need some help setting up homes. It takes less than two hours from start to finish. Many hands make for light work. We also need help cleaning homes (again, this can take less than two hours time).



Liturgy Corner Anointing of the Sick

Next weekend, at all our Masses, we celebrate the Anointing of the Sick. In the Church's Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them. When He physically walked among us, His cures were signs of the arrival of the Kingdom of God.

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The anointing can be received anytime - before surgery, before or during treatments. When the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, **the person be physically healed of illness.** But even if there is no physical healing, the **primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage** to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.
