## **PARISH NEWS** • Letter from Our Pastor

- ..."Then the righteous will answer him and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you? And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.' This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. The Gospel outlines the vision of the King and work of His Kingdom. There will be a moment when all of us have to stand before the King. We clearly hear **Christ's expectations for us.** As we bring to a close the Church year and prepare for the start of Advent next weekend, it's a moment for us to reflect on our lives, our blessings, and how well we are living out the expectation of the King and doing the work of His Kingdom.
- ...This past week was filled with God's grace and blessing for us as a parish community. God's grace and our goodness allowed us take care of thousands and thousands of our sisters and brothers in need. The best of the stories comes from last Saturday during our Catholic Works of Mercy Thanksgiving Food distribution. Typically, we take care of 135-150 families. Given all things, the CWM planned for 165. By the time the day was over, 210 families showed up asking for help with Thanksgiving **Food.** Just like the Gospel story of the multiplication of the loaves, the CWM kept going into the Food Pantry and kept coming out with what every family needed. - ... A few weeks back we collected 1,225 **turkeys.** By the time everything is said and done, especially with the extra families who needed help, every turkey was used well to care for those in need. What we do for the least, we do for the Lord. Many thanks to the cooking, carving, prepping, packing and delivery teams who helped take the cooked Thanksgiving meals all over the region. God bless the planning team and all who were so generous with their time and donations. Special thanks to our friends at Marc's for their support of this special outreach effort. A little Marc's trivia for you. A huge need to make the Thanksgiving Meal program (and the PB&J brigade) work is boxes. They delivered pallets of boxes (among other things) to help make our efforts easy and possible. We are blessed!!!!
- ...I could go on and on and on about all the good we did these past weeks here, in Cleveland, with food, turkeys and the greatest of care and love. **The best moment for me was watching moms**

- with their kids select from your gently used coats, hats and gloves so their kids and family will be warm this winter.
  They were thrilled. They were excited.
  They were so grateful. I cannot put into words the deep gratitude I have in my heart for your goodness and the great good we do together. As I reflect on the expectations and vision of Christ the King, I believe that we, as a community of faith, are working hard to bring His vision and live out these expectation together in our community and across our region. God bless you over and again.
- ...This weekend, we invite all those who are struggle with health of mind, body, spirit, to be Anointed with the Holy Oil. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is a most tender gesture of Christ the King to bring us comfort, healing, hope and peace in our lives. It is the hopeful assurance that God is with us on our journey. If you are reading this online, please bring your family members and neighbors to the Font of Mercy, Jesus Christ.
- ...Last Sunday evening we had a most beautiful prayer service to help us reflect on the reasons for our gratitude.
