PARISH NEWS • Letter from Our Pastor

- ..."And for this reason we too give thanks to God unceasinaly, that, in receiving the word of God from hearing us, you received not a human word but, as it truly is, the word of God, which is now at work in you who believe." Saint Paul to the Thessalonians reminds us that we too have reason to give thanks to God unceasingly. In these autumn days, take some time to reflect deeply on the **blessings of God in your life.** Try not to miss 'counting' any one of the blessings. By the time the day is done, you should be overwhelmed by the goodness and graciousness of God. This should lead to your giving thanks and praise to God - unceasingly. This should lead you to say....we are....simply blessed!!!
- ...It's hard to believe that we've landed in November. Thanksgiving is soon upon **us.** It's a national day of giving thanks – of being mindful of the blessings. We are so blessed. I can share with you, first hand, that the needs of so many in our local community and in our region are great. We've been receiving the calls for help, support and Thanksgiving Food. Many thanks to all who are so supportive of our Catholic Works of Mercy efforts to care for those in need in our local community. We are working to take care of 9,200 people on Thanksgiving. This means that we need 1,100 frozen turkeys and lots - and lots - and lots of pies. Next weekend we will be collecting turkeys and pies so that so many in our region can receive a great meal for Thanksgiving - thanks to your goodness. Together we will be a blessing to all of our sisters and brothers in need.
- ...This coming Tuesday is **Election Day.** There are two important issues facing all of us - Issue One and Issue Two. It's important that you take time to learn what's in the law and prayerfully discern the good and holy decision. The Bishops of the State of Ohio have taken a clear and strong position on these two issues. They call all of us to vote NO on both issues. Issue One that legalizes abortion is poorly written law. Issue Two which legalizes marijuana will only accelerate the breakdown of our society and family life. Please go to StAmbrose.us/Vote to learn more about these important issues so you can make an informed and prayerful decision for yourself and the good of the community.
- ...This Monday and Tuesday we are inviting all of you to spend some extra time in prayer. May God bless our country and help people discern what is good, and right, and holy for the good of

- our State and community. We will be offering Eucharistic Adoration starting on Monday at 9 am (like usual) and continue throughout the night to Tuesday evening at 8 pm. We need to be a people who are 'under God' so we can help our country live the values of the Lord. Please make an extra effort to stop in the chapel and spend some time in prayer.
- ... This past week 19 families in our school were awarded \$52,000 between them from the Angel Scholarship Fund. You may recall that that State of Ohio has created a program that you can receive a credit towards your State of Ohio taxes (\$750 per person and \$1500 per couple) when you make the contribution to the Angel Scholarship Fund. This is an amazing opportunity, with no additional cost to you, to help make sure all our families have the opportunity to receive the support they need to attend Saint Ambrose School. - ...On Sunday evening, we are blessed to commission many of our PSR students who are making a commitment to serve one of our Liturgical Ministries (lector, server, greeter, art/environment). It's a special privilege and joy to serve at the Table of the Lord. Please pray for our young people as they say'yes' to serving the Lord and our parish community.
- ...So many commented how much you appreciated seeing/hearing/meeting both Nathan Frankart and Dominic Kucera last weekend on Priesthood Sunday.

Dominic is in his first year of college. He and his family are members of our parish. Nathan is doing his internship year at Saint Ambrose. Together you could see - and feel - the faith and energy these two guys bring to the Lord and,

hopefully, to a life of ministry and service to the Church. This coming Wednesday, Nathan will be taking the junior high students from Saint Ambrose School to the seminary for a visit and to learn more about opening their hearts to the Lord. **Pray for our young people. Pray for vocations.**

... This Monday our Endowment Committee is offering another helpful presentation on Year-End Tax Planning and Qualified Distribution. Come and hear our panel of experts as they help us make sure we have good information for our planning.
