- ...God willing, we will be blessed with many guests and visitors for Christmas. Your warm welcome and active participation in prayer can make the difference to make our guests regular active members of our community of faith at Christmas and always.



We know it can be challenging for families with young children to participate weekly in Mass. While young children cannot fully understand all that goes on at Mass, there are times within the Mass that they can participate in some ways.


They can learn to genuflect and bow; say the Our Father; offer the Sign of Peace; children grades K-3 can participate in the Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) during the 4:30 pm; 9:00 am and 10:30 am. At CLOW they will hear the scripture readings in an age-appropriate version.

In the next few weeks, all the children of the parish will receive their Offering envelopes; on the box of the envelopes will be suggestions and ideas of how

we can teach our children ways to honor God, help take care of each other and place their envelope in the basket. Children can join our Journey with Jesus program that is offered in the school for preschool children aged 3-5 years old during 9:00 am and 10:30 am Mass. For those children who love to sing, our Angels and Cherub Choirs sings once a month at our 9:00am. When we bring our children to Mass, they hear the Word of God and prayers praising Him. Those prayers, songs and phrases expressing the foundations of our faith are repeated week after week, are seeds of faith that will stay with our children forever.






