

Upcoming: Feast of the Presentation of the Lord & Throat Blessing

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is also known as Candlemas Day. Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple for the rites of purification and dedication. The Gospel of Luke mentions the Presentation of Our Lord, "for it is written in the law of the Lord, 'Every first-born male shall be consecrated to the Lord'" (Lk 2:22-23). Jesus is presented as the priest who will offer Himself as the perfect sacrifice to free us from the slavery of sin, seal the new and eternal covenant with His blood, and open the gates to the true promised land of heaven.

He is the light who came into this world to dispel sin and darkness. For this reason, traditionally, candles that are used throughout the year are blessed at Mass, hence coining the term "Candlemas." Not every parish will have blessing of candles, as it is not necessary to have only beeswax taper candles to be blessed for use. Candles designated for religious use in the Church or home can be any style: votive, tealight, or taper.
