

### **PARISH NEWS** • Letter from Our Pastor

- ..."A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then, warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once." Today's Gospel is another powerful story of Jesus' desire to help and heal. Jesus' constant took care of those 'left out and pushed out' by society. He is the Font of Mercy. He is the healing grace and perfect love each of us need and seek. Even on days when we feel unlovable, Jesus loves us and cares for us...now and always.
- ...This weekend we have two opportunities to continue Jesus' work and ministry of caring for those on the 'margin.' On this Superbowl Sunday, our junior high and high school students will be at the doors of the Church and in Hilkert Hall asking for your support for the Souper Bowl of Caring. Proceeds from this effort are used to support our monthly community meal program. In January, our community provided fresh, homemade meals for 508 people in our local community. There are many, especially our seniors, who struggle with food poverty. This monthly fresh, flavorful meal is a way of offering some support and, especially, making sure they know that we, as a community of faith, care greatly for them and about them. To provide about 6,000 meals this year (not counting Thanksgiving/November), we need to raise at least \$18,000. Any help and support would be greatly appreciated by our teens and those we serve. # **Liturgy Corner**The Steps of Christian Initiation

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process through which non-baptized men and women enter the Catholic Church. It includes several stages marked by study, prayer and rites at Mass.

With the guidance and preparations by a priest and a catechist, the person may seek acceptance into the Order of Catechumens, through the **Rite of Acceptance**. During this rite, he/she stands before the parish community and states that he/she wants to become a baptized member of the Catholic

Church. As a sign of their new way of life, the catechumens are signed with the cross + on the forehead along with all the senses (ears, eyes, lips) heart, shoulder, hands and feet.

This Sunday, at the 10:30 am Mass, our RCIA catechumens will celebrate the Rite of Signing. At this rite, each of them are called up to sign their name in a book. They also affirm and state his or her intention and readiness to make a faith commitment.

On February 11, the **Rite of Election** includes the enrollment of names of all the Catechumens seeking baptism; they are then called the Elect.

At the Easter Vigil, the **Elect are Baptized, Confirmed, and make their First Holy Communion**, thus becoming full members of the Body of Christ, the Church.



### **Rite of Election**

We will be celebrating the **Rite of Election with our catechumens at Saint John Cathedral on Sunday, February 18.** As they take the next step on their journey of faith, please continue to pray for our **18 adults and 11 children** who will be celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.

Catechumens indicate their desire to join the Church by signing the Book of the Elect, giving them the title "members of the elect." The word "election", in this case has nothing to do with politics; rather, it is a discernment that God is present in the lives of the catechumens and is inviting them into a fuller life of the sacraments.

Celebration of the rite has two parts: a sending and a receiving. First, catechumens are sent by their parishes. This is a public pronouncement that they are ready to enter a covenant relationship through participation in the sacramental life of the Church. This is the first of many sendings they will experience in their faith journey. Those who are sent can then be received. The bishop accepts the parish community's judgment, receives the catechumens and invites them to enter their names in the Book of the Elect.

### **Catechumen Spotlights**

Over the next few weeks, we will be highlighting our Journey to Emmaus catechumens. Their journey is as important to us as it is to them and along with our prayers, we encourage our members to connect with these special individuals to make them feel even more welcome into our faith and our community.

Meet, Shaun Hahner. His faith journey actually began because of and with his family - his son was baptized this past fall and his daughter will be

was baptized this past fall and his daughter will be receiving the Sacraments of Initiation with him at the Easter Vigil. Shaun shares that the "One thing I like about the Journey to Emmaus process is sharing some moments of faith with my wife and children at Mass."

Meet, Jennifer Eich who has thought about converting for a while. Then, she got engaged and for her fiancé and her, it was important that they







# Mission Rice Bowl

Your Lenten Sacrifice will help to keep their bowls filled in the Dominican Republic.

It costs \$14,000 to build a 528 sq. ft. home (average family is 6 people).

Each home consists of 1 bathroom, 2 bedrooms, a cooking area (not a full kitchen), a living room and a porch.

A 25 lb bag of rice costs about \$18 US dollars and a ½ gallon of cooking oil costs about \$17 Us dollors. The rice will feed the family for several weeks. For most families, rice is the main meal they will eat each day along with some beans and maybe, if they're lucky, chicken or pork.

The average worker works a 10-14 hour day in construction, agriculture or the local hotels and makes about \$18.00 a day.

A liter of gasoline costs about 157 pesos...... or \$4.90/gallon. Almost no one in our communities has a car, several have motorbikes but most rely on public transportation or friends to

get to work or into the city.



#### MEDICINE AND HEALTH CARE! Last

year the Clinic in our community and our Medical Outreach team provided medicine and care to thousands of patients!



DOUBLE YOUR IMPACT!

The Lent Rice Bowls will be distributed and available at all the doors of the Church starting on Ash Wednesday. Small change and sacrifice can make a world of difference for those we serve in our mission community in the Dominican Republic. This year, a couple in our parish have offered to 'match' your sacrifice so we can raise enough funds to build at least two houses in the mission. Remember they have gone through two hurricanes and a tropical storm over the past year. As a parish if we raise \$14,500 (the cost of a house), they will match it and two families will move this Fall from tin shacks to a 440 sq. ft. house.
