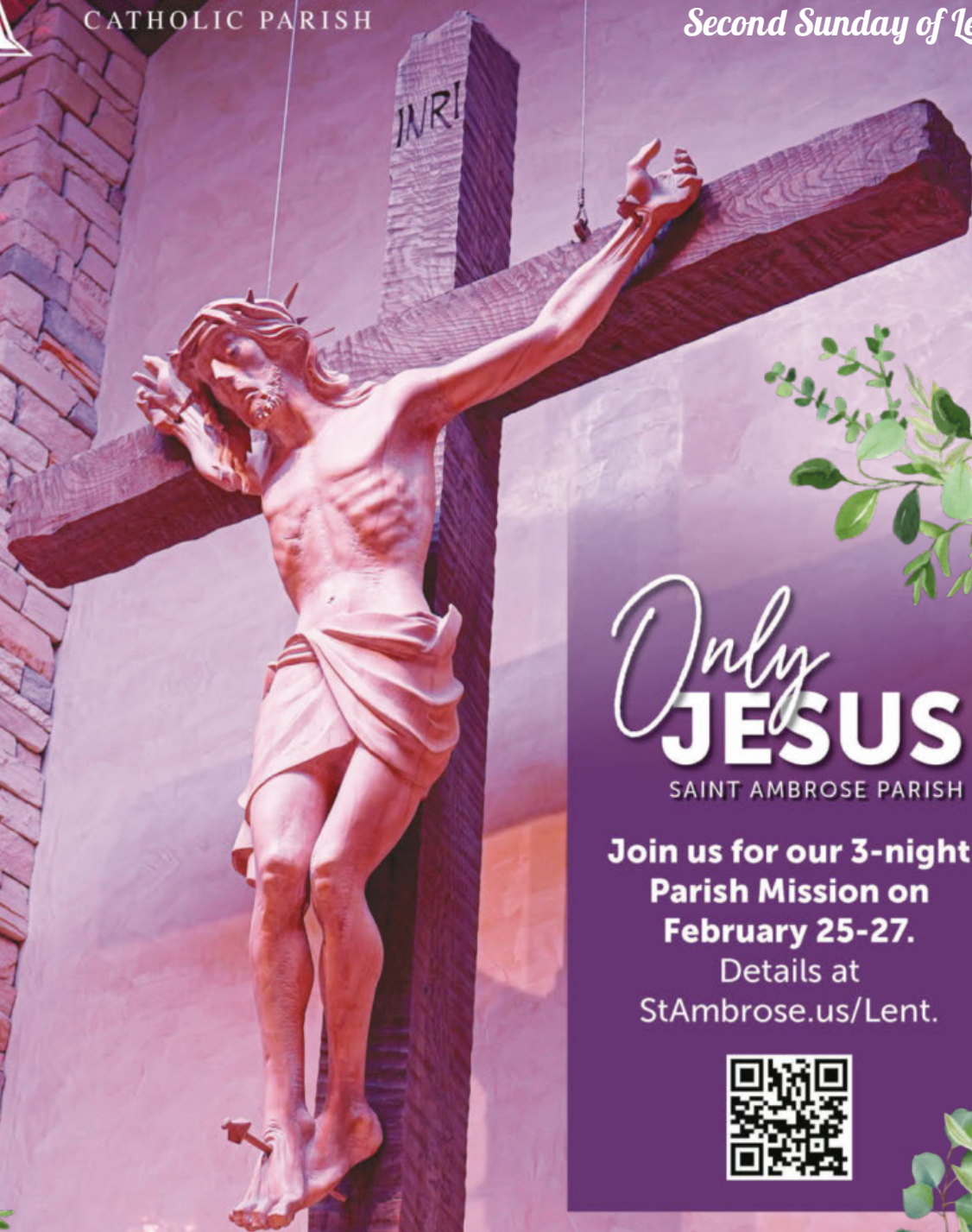

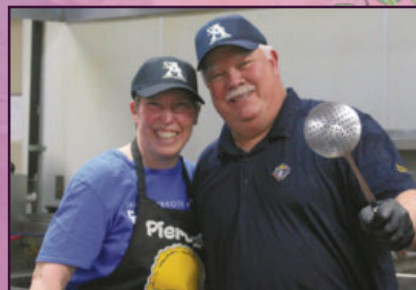

...**"God put Abraham to the test. He called to him, 'Abraham!' 'Here I am!'" he replied. Then God said: "Take your son Isaac, your only one, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah. There you shall offer him up as a holocaust on a height that I will point out to you." When they came to the place of which God had told him, Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood on it. Then he reached out and took the knife to slaughter his son. But the LORD's messenger called to him from heaven, "Abraham, Abraham!" "Here I am!" he answered.**" Our first reading, on this Second Sunday of Lent, is a powerful lesson. God never said it was going to be easy. Even more, look to the example of Abraham who was asked to make a great. In those challenging moments, Abraham found the grace to say 'yes'. God blesses every sacrifice and every 'yes' Abraham (and each of us) make. **God does promise, in our struggles, to show us the better way and offers us the grace and strength we need for the journey.** Abraham goes on to be the leader of the people and blessed beyond measure. Let's pray for the grace to say "Here I am Lord" even in the difficult and challenging moments of our lives.

...Many thanks to all who have started the prayer partner project. **Long story short, at the doors of the Church, and over at the PLC reception area, you will find blank cards asking for your prayer intention. Simply write that intention and drop it in the basket.** At the same time, dig deep and pick up someone else's prayer need/intention. It's really that simple. We pray with - and for one another. The blessings that come from knowing we are being held in prayer are real. It's a powerful way of interceding and asking God's mercy upon our sisters and brothers. Let's pray faithfully to the Lord our God.

...**This weekend you are sitting on new pew benches.** As I shared a while back, they were replaced because they did not perform as well as promised. Hopefully, the new finish they used with help protect the wood and minimize scratches. **Please, please** we all need to do our part as well. Things like **keys** are not good on the wooden benches. Journey to Emmaus God is Present in Their Lives

What a joy it was to celebrate the Rite of Election with our Catechumens and Candidates down at the Cathedral last week. The Rite of Election indicates the desire of the Catechumens to join the church, giving them the title "members of the elect" and discerning that God is indeed present in their lives and inviting them into a fuller life of the Sacraments.



First Scrutiny

The First Scrutiny, the Elect have hands laid upon them and are prayed over and will pray that they may reject everything in their lives that is contrary to Christ.

Catechumen Spotlights

As we journey through the season of Lent, we invite you to remember in your prayers the 19 adults and 6 children who are preparing for the Easter Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. May they know the prayerful support, care, and warm embrace of our parish community.

Meet, Molly Mason. She began seeking a deeper understanding of the Catholic faith after witnessing her sister, Caitlin go through the Journey last year. Molly started going to Mass with her sister and felt something shift in her. She says, *"the very atmosphere was so Holy that it drew me to prayer."* Molly also says that her Journey to Emmaus has been a positive one and it has been *"refreshing to find a community of likeminded people to share the burdens and joys of being a Christian."*



Meet, Tim Smith who shares that deciding to Journey to Emmaus has been a long time coming. He says that he had been "looking for someplace to worship and I wasn't happy with anything I was finding." He went to many other churches but just could not find a place. *"I saw on the Saint Ambrose sign, 'You are Welcome Here' and that really called out to me,"* according to Tim. That simple, yet heartfelt message broke the ice enough to put Tim on the path to inquiry. Now, Tim is on the Journey to Emmaus and shares that the process has given him the opportunity to learn in an *"environment that is welcoming and the program is led by a wonderful team."*

The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross and the Way of Sorrow (Via Crucis in Latin), commemorate Jesus's passion and death on the day he died on cross. 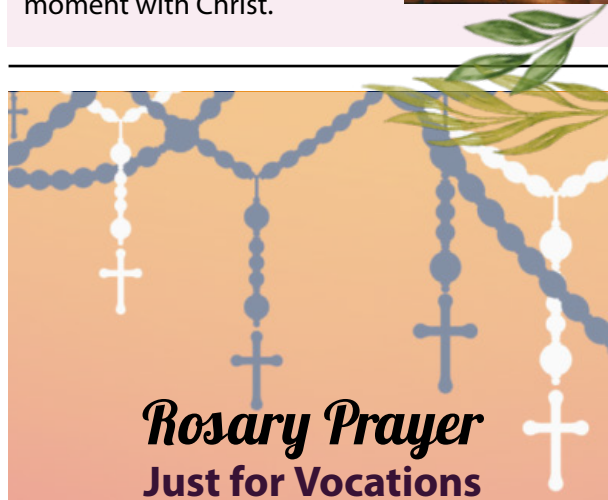
- On March 1, we will use the version - **Praying the Stations with Saint Joseph.**

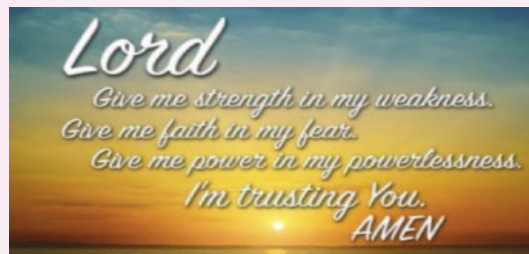

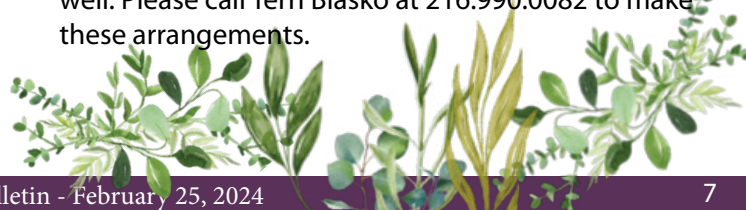
Women's Guild Rolls Sale
