## **Liturgy Corner** Tenebrae Service

"Tenebrae" is the Latin word meaning "darkness." The story of the suffering and death of Jesus during the three days leading up to Easter, also known as the Sacred Triduum.

At the Tenebrae service, there will be seven candles at the altar, shaped like a triangle. Psalms will be sung or chanted

along with readings. As the psalms and readings are completed, one candle is extinguished, until only the lone candle is left; a powerful reminder of the apostles abandoning Christ in his darkest hour. By tradition, the seventh candle (representing Christ, light of the world) is not extinguished. At the end,



a loud sound is made to convey the sense of total loss of God's presence, the death of Jesus. The final story of the burial is read in near darkness.

On Holy Thursday, the altar is decorated, and we can keep company with Our Lord. On Good Friday, we venerate the Cross, we can kiss the feet of Our Lord, and receive Him in the Eucharist. But Tenebrae is sorrowful, from beginning to end, complete with darkness, 'earthquake', and Our Lord symbolically hidden from our view. We leave in silence to ponder the impact of Christ's death and await the celebration of the coming Resurrection. I urge you to consider coming if you haven't before, and experience this deeply moving, and prayerful part of Holy Week.



## **Lenten Prayer Services and Reconciliation**
