PARISH NEWS • Letter from Our Pastor

..."Some Greeks who had come to worship at the Passover Feast came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus."" The simple thought for today's Gospel speaks volumes to each of us this Lent. Can you imagine if each of us had the desire every day to 'see Jesus." Only Jesus can heal us...forgive us...save us. Only Jesus...can give us everything we need. Only Jesus is our way, our truth and our life. Can you imagine if, over and again, we had the deepest desire to 'see Jesus.'

... As we come to an end of the Lenten Season (this is our last full week), take some time to reflect on your own life - the commitments you made on Ash Wednesday. Have you taken the time to 'see Jesus' in prayer, reflection, and in daily life? ONLY Jesus is the answer – our savior - our everything. How can you plan now to make Holy Week (which starts next Sunday – Palm Sunday) a priority for you and your family? Today's bulletin includes a complete schedule of services and opportunities for prayer. Come and spend time with Jesus. Focus on His life, His ministry, and His complete self-offering for you.

...Next weekend is Palm Sunday. Please wear RED to Church. It's a way to help all of us reflect on the passion of our Lord Jesus Christ. Also, invite your family, neighbors and friends to join you. One of our members tells the story that they invited their grandson to join them for Christmas (it's all she wanted). The Grandson now joins her every weekend. Your invitation can make all the difference!!!

...The movie, The Passion of the Christ, is coming to Hickory Ridge Cinema next Saturday and Sunday. It was released 20 years ago and powerfully tells the story of Jesus' journey to the Cross. Thanks to Betty Ann and Scott Hodan, the movie will be shown both nights at 6:30 pm. Tickets are \$6 per person. It's a great way to reflect on the immense sacrifice of love that Jesus made for you and for me. Spread the word. The movie has helped so many understand the passion and deepen their appreciation of the immense love of Jesus in their life.

...The Knights of Columbus are leading a national effort to make Good Friday a priority. On Good Friday we remember the saving deeds of Jesus. It should be, for all of us, a day of prayer and reflection. I remember growing up, for my family, how important it was to keep a spirit of quiet and reflection from 12 noon to 3 pm. **On Good Friday we will pray the Stations** of the Cross at 12 noon. The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ is celebrated at 3 pm. Our FIAT teens will present the Living Stations with soul stirring music/ songs at 8 pm. Make Good Friday a priority.

..."Our sins they are many...His mercy is more." There are a few additional opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation this Lent. **Come and experience God's mercy on: Friday, March 22 at 1 pm; Sunday, March 24 at 6 pm; and Thursday, March 21 at 6 pm.** "His mercy is more!"

... This past week we were blessed to gather together the 45 missionaries who will head to our mission community this June. We have a great group of adults and teens who are eager to serve in the name of the Lord and help some of the poorest of the poor in our world. One way all of us can 'serve' and help those in need is through our Lenten Rice Bowls. Small change will make a big difference. Our mission community endured two hurricanes and one tropical storm this past year. We had to demolish 10 houses and replace 60 tin roofs. Your Lenten sacrifice can help rebuild these homes. A couple in our parish has offered to 'match' your sacrifice. A new house costs \$15,000, they will match your gift so we can help those most in need. You can turn in your rice bowls to the Parish Office or Church sacristy.

...Thanks to our amazing Women's Guild, our monthly community meal offered about 400 people homemade stuffed cabbage for Saint Patrick's Day. The monthly meeting brings together about 50-60 of our women who do great work for the Lord and share an incredible bond of friendship. God bless the Women's Guild. Check out their Easter Nut and Poppyseed Rolls they will be selling this weekend at Coffee and Doughnuts.

...As we enter into Holy Week, **come** and learn more about the Passion narrative. I am using my next Synoptic Class (Monday, March 25) to help us reflect and learn more about the timeless story of Jesus' passion and death. The class takes place in the Mother Teresa Room starting at 6:45 pm.

...Please pray for the 19 adults and 6 children who are preparing to join the Church at the Easter Vigil. They are a sign of God's grace and goodness in our community. They reflect the promise of new life for all of us this Easter Season. They have the deep desire to 'see Jesus' and God is blessing this deep desire in their hearts. ...Janet Majka is such a blessing to our parish community. She has been coordinating our Emmaus Journey for these adults and children. Janet is dealing with some health issues and needs our prayers for health and healing.

...This coming Wednesday is our annual Seder Meal starting at 5:30 pm. It recounts the traditional Seder Meal that Jesus would have shared with his disciples. There's room for you to come and experience this prayerful and powerful ritual meal. To sign up, contact Teresa McCombs at TMcCombs@StAmbrose.us.

...Next Friday join us for Tenebrae at 7 pm. Come and celebrate this powerful service of moving from Light to Darkness to the Eternal Light that only Jesus can provide. The music and chants will stir your soul and help you prepare for Holy Week.

...This coming Tuesday is Election Day. **Practice faithful citizenship** by taking the time to learn about the candidates and issues, bring them to prayer, and then **VOTE.**

...Sunday is the Feast of Saint Patrick. Over all the doors of our Church hangs the Celtic Trinity – many persons united and bound together by the love of God. Saint Patrick was a great evangelizer – spreading the Gospel and helping people seek and 'see' the power of God in their lives. Let's use this Feast as a moment to invite others to come to the Lord. Invite your family and friends to join you on Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter. Let's spread the Good News – ONLY Jesus can satisfy the longings of every heart.

...Last week we had a huge funeral of a man with a strong and faithful Irish family. The Church was full because, for him and his family – faith and family – go hand in hand. It was such a blessing to be with his family – as it is for us to be with all those we commend to God's eternal care. We are blessed with wonderful members who assist in our funeral ministry (greeters, New Life Choir, and Acolytes (Mass Servers). We need some additional people to join in this very special ministry. 

Liturgy Corner

Each year on March 19, we celebrate the Feast of Saint Joseph who was the husband of Mary and the earthly father of Jesus. Joseph is often referred to as the father in the shadows. In fact, none of Joseph's words are written in the Gospels and little was recorded about his life. **But, you can follow Joseph's life depicted on the Joseph's wall in our Church.**

Symbols associated with Joseph include the carpenter's square and lily. The carpenter's square not only symbolizes Joseph's trade but also the concept of truth. The lily represents purity and Joseph's celibate marriage to the Virgin Mary.



Joseph is the patron saint

of the Universal Church, families, fathers, expectant mothers, travelers, immigrants, house sellers and buyers, craftsmen, engineers and working people, among others.

It is said that Pope Francis keeps in his room an image of a sleeping Saint Joseph, a weary traveler fleeing with his family to Egypt. The pope places notes of special intercession on pieces of paper under the statue, perhaps asking the fatherly saint to intercede to God for a special need. Afterward, all of the food is then usually donated to the poor. The Solemnity of Saint Joseph occurs during Lent, a time of reflection, humility, and almsgiving.




Parish School of Religion **Living Stations Prayer**




