



PARISH NEWS • Letter from Our Pastor

- \dots "Christ Jesus, though He was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, He humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that *Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God* **the Father."** The second reading on this Passion/Palm Sunday could be summed up – ONLY Jesus. Only Jesus humbled himself and became like us. **ONLY Jesus** so perfectly embraced the will and the work of the Father by giving His life for US. **ONLY Jesus** opened the way to Heaven. **ONLY Jesus** is all we need. He is our everything.
- ...This week this HOLY WEEK our focus and our priority needs to be ONLY Jesus. Imagine if we all used this week to focus on Jesus His mercy is More. His forgiveness is More. He is our everything. "Only this I want, but to know the Lord." Take some time to reflect on your schedule for the week. How can you make Jesus and only Jesus the focus of your day, week and life.
- ...We started the season of Lent with some clear focus and goals to help us grow in our personal relationship with the Lord. Early in Lent we heard of the spiritual tools of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. As you enter this Holy Week, where are you at on your Lenten journey? How can you take advantage of this Holy Week and the many opportunities to gather in prayer and reflection?
- ...On Ash Wednesday so many took home a Lent Rice Bowl – small change makes a big difference. We turn our Lenten sacrifices into homes for the poorest of the poor. Remember, you can bring your rice bowl back to Church (sacristy) or drop it at the parish office. You can also drop any rice bowl donation in the collection (marked Rice Bowl). If we can raise \$15,000 this Lent, one of our families will match that generosity so we can build two homes this summer in **our mission community.** We have about 50 missionaries headed to our mission in June. Together we can change the world for those we care for and serve.
- ...This coming Monday, March 25, I will be using the Synoptic Gospel session to focus on the Passion of Christ. It's a

- perfect way to prepare for the retelling of the saving deeds of Jesus this Holy Week. Join us in the Mother Teresa Room at 6:45 pm.
- ...One of our favorite songs, "His Mercy is More." This Sunday evening (Palm Sunday) we have several priests who are available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) from 6 pm to 7 pm. This will be your last opportunity to celebrate the sacrament and experience the forgiveness and mercy of God before Easter (next Sunday).
- ...Join us on Holy Thursday as we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30 pm. It's a beautiful way to enter into the Sacred Triduum (Holy Three Days). At Mass we will commission some of our members to serve as Eucharistic Ministers, and several of our teens as Masters of Ceremonies for our weekend Masses. Both are examples of our members continuing the work and mission of Jesus. Jesus calls all of us to 'serve' the Lord and continue the work of building up God's Kingdom. God bless these members who are saying 'yes' to the call to holiness and service.
- ...Just like Jesus' did with His earlier followers, we will journey together to the Garden (Hilkert Courtyard, 8:30 pm 10:30 pm and then in the Church, from 11:00 pm 8:00 am) to spend the night in vigil and prayer with the Lord. Make a commitment to spend some time in prayer with the Lord at the Grotto until 10;30 pm and throughout the night in the Chapel. You can sign up for Vigil and Adoration by going to: www.StAmbrose. us/
-On Good Friday, we have three opportunities to remember the Journey of Jesus to the Cross. Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 12 pm, noon. The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ will be celebrated at 3 pm. Our fiat teens will bring to life the Living Stations at 8 pm.
- ...Our Lent Fish Fry Season comes to a close on Good Friday from 430 pm to 7:00 pm. Come for a flavorful Lent meal. You can eat in or carry out. All the details can be found at: www.StAmbrose.us/fish-fry. Special thanks to our Fish Fry Team for their hard work for our parish community. We are so blessed by their dedication and commitment to our parish community. Show your appreciation and support by joining us for the last Fish Friday on Good Friday. The proceeds from this year's Fish Fry will help us replace/update the 17 year old front sign on Pearl Road.
- ...Bring your kids and grandkids with you

- to Church for the **Easter Food Basket blessing on Holy Saturday at 1 pm.** It's a great family tradition that keeps us all mindful that God is the giver of every good gift (and all good food).
- ...After the Easter Basket Blessing, all the kids and grandkids will take to the fields for our amazing Easter Egg Hunt. There's plenty of eggs and lots of Easter fun. The Easter Bunny will be with us, along with some great games, music, activities and games. All the fun begins at 1:30 pm.
- ...On **Holy Saturday,** we celebrate the Easter Vigil at 8:45 pm. We start with new 'fire' to remind us that the Light of Christ is ever fresh and new. We bless new 'water' to proclaim the Living Water of Jesus can refresh each of us every day and always. **ONLY Jesus** can roll away the stone, be the Light stronger than the darkness, and be the flowing river of God's grace that washes us in the mercy and compassion of God. Please pray for the 19 adults and 6 children who will come to the Living Water through Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist (the three sacraments of initiation). Please pray for them as they choose 'Jesus' in their life. May God bless them with His amazing grace.
- ...Special thanks to Janet Majka and the RCIA Team for journeying with our sisters and brothers who are joining our parish community. We are so blessed by your ministry and being faithful companions on the journey.
- ...As you have been reading over the past few weeks, we are looking for a person to help 'oversee' our PSR program on Monday and Wednesday. 

Some students even came out of their Confession beaming and wanting to share that confessing their sins and receiving absolution made them feel *"lighter and closer to God."*



We, the parish leadership and PSR catechists, would like to thank the parents of our PSR students. Your faith in God and your love for your children allows us to witness how Jesus demonstrates His power to heal these amazing young people and raise them to a new life free from the bondage of sin.
