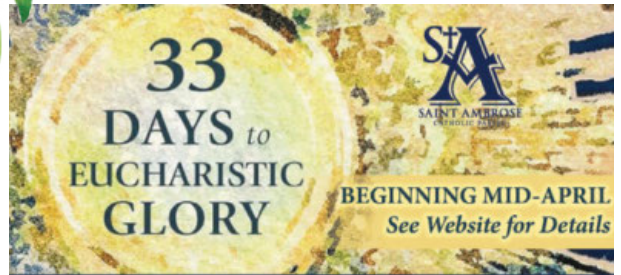
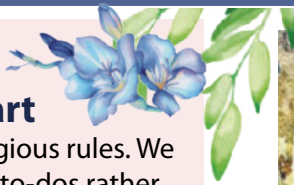
We are Here for You.

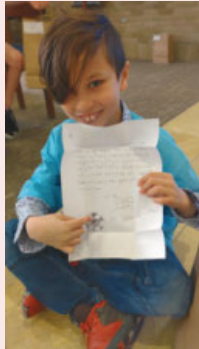

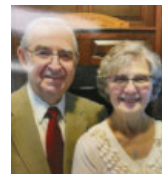

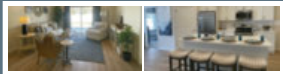
