
# Monthly Healing Prayer

# **First Eucharist**

First Holy Communion (First Eucharist) is an important and meaningful occasion in the life of a Catholic child, as it **brings them closer to Christ and allows them to experience the actual presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.** First Holy Communion is the second of the three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism and Confirmation), which complete an individual's inclusion into the Catholic Community.
