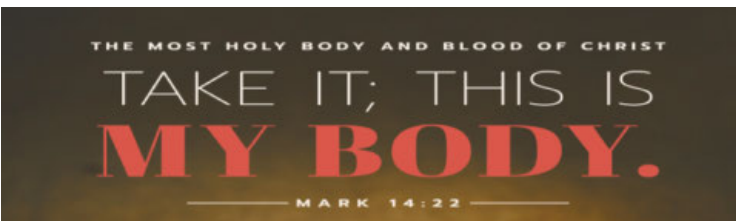

Memorial Garden – A Tribute

Father Bob's homily last Sunday talked about getting involved, recognizing your skills, and how you can help here at Saint Ambrose Parish. **And Marguerite & Steve Wyderka have done just that as members of our Adopt-a-Patch Ministry.** Their patch is the one by the Narthex entrance – the military patch. Marguerite says, *"We chose a Memorial Garden theme for our patch because it is a tribute to our fathers. My dad, Sgt. Frank Kaminski served in the Korean War. He was a paratrooper who did 33 jumps, which included two jumps in Inchon. He received the Silver Star, Bronze Star, and two Purple Hearts. During his time in Korea, his whole troop was killed. When he received his medals, they had a plaque of all the fallen soldiers. At the ceremony, he said that his medals weren't important and that it was his comrades and the sacrifice they had made that mattered. Steve's dad also served during the Korean War as a Second-Class seaman on the USS Kermit Roosevelt. He was a shipfitter and metal smith. Many uncles, cousins, and nephews also served in various military branches."*

As we commemorate this Memorial Day, we pause to **remember and honor all those who have selflessly served our country.** Their dedication and sacrifice are deeply appreciated. **We also extend our heartfelt condolences to the families who have lost their loved ones in service.** May their memories be a source of strength and inspiration for us all.

May is Mental Health Awareness Month

We are so blessed to have a strong and active Mental Health Team serving our parish community and our members. They are always working to foster awareness, advocacy, and support around mental health issues and those in need of help. We are so blessed. We have long said that our community "C.A.R.E.S." which means: **C**oncerned + **A**lert + **R**esponsive -> **E**veryone Safe.

A Note from Our Mental Health Ministry:

"Sometimes I feel lost," said the boy. "Me too," said the mole, "but we love you, and love brings you home."

"Sometimes," said the horse. "Sometimes what?" asked the boy. "Sometimes just getting up and carrying on is brave and magnificent."

"What do we do when our hearts hurt?" asked the boy. "We wrap them with friendship, shared tears, and time, till they wake hopeful and happy again."

"Asking for help isn't giving up," said the horse. "It's refusing to give up."

These Charlie Mackery's quotes are worth your time and reflection as we celebrate Mental Health Awareness Month. Our Saint Ambrose Mental Health Ministry (MHM) focuses on three things for those dealing with mental health conditions:

1. **Accompaniment** – We walk with you in faith and love when a teen, young adult, or family member is dealing with a mental health condition. Most of us didn't think mental illness would happen to us or in our families. Mental illness, depression, and anxiety happens in all types of individuals and families. Our trained and committed team is here to make sure that no person has to suffer alone. We make sure that persons with mental health conditions recognize that they are in a "no judgment zone" where simple gifts of friendship, prayer, and encouragement are readily present and available.
2. **Education** – MHM connects persons in need with knowledge, resources, and relationships in our faith and civic communities. We provide preventive trainings and resources to help parents know what to look for and how to develop resilience in children and young adults regarding mental health issues. We provide responsive trainings and resources to address common mental health conditions: anxiety, depression, and suicide awareness and prevention. Healthy and loving families and faith communities talk about things that matter – including mental health and mental illness.
3. **Resources** – We have formed relationships with the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), Catholic Charities, LifeAct, and other mental health organizations to help persons in need access and receive mental health services. Saint Ambrose has a monthly NAMI group that meets the third Thursday of each month and our Mental Health Ministry team meets on the first Monday of each month.

What can you do now: Be a trustworthy and caring adult for young people – not only your children. Recall caring adults who walked with you along the way with kindness, tenderness, and support. Work together to provide access to Mental Health support in our parish and community. Families struggling with mental health conditions never imagined they would be in this position. Too many people are struggling, often silently. They need help... mostly, they need HOPE.

Loving God, You are always near us, especially when we are weak, suffering, and vulnerable. Reach out to those who experience mental illness. Lift their burdens, calm their anxiety, and quiet their fears. Surround them with Your healing presence so they may know they are not alone. We ask this in the name of Your Son, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, now and forever. Amen.

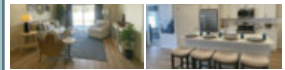
