

- ..."Jesus answered them and said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him the Father, **God, has set his seal."** A few weeks back. Catholics from across the country gathered in Indianapolis for the 10th Eucharistic Congress.
