

This is a powerful question that must be asked and answered if we want to avoid a haphazard, disjointed, and chaotic life. It also must be asked and answered if we claim to be a person of faith who is committed to living the Gospel of Jesus Christ.


can gain great control. It is the discipline of prayer that allows us to become the very likeness of God!




# An Exciting New Ministry! Come to Our Upcoming Meeting




