

PARISH NEWS • Letter from Our Pastor

- ..."As the visions during the night continued, I saw one like a Son of man coming, on the clouds of heaven; when he reached the Ancient One and was presented before him, the one like a Son of man received dominion, glory, and kingship; all peoples, nations, and languages serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not be taken away, his kingship shall not be destroyed." This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This feast reminds us of two key thoughts: 1. The Christ as King will make all things right and 2. Working for His Kingdom is most important. As we renew our commitment to our King, Jesus Christ, we renew our efforts to build His kingdom of justice, mercy and peace for all of God's children.
- ...Every time you pray The Lord's Prayer, we pray, "Thy Kingdom come. They Will be done." These two phrases work together. The more we live out the will of God in our lives, the more we will be building God's kingdom here and now and forever.
- ...The vision of God's Kingdom can best be seen in our efforts last weekend and this coming week. Together we collected over 1,300 turkeys, along with hundreds of pies and donations so that together we can feed 10,000 people this week. What a blessing!!! This means that we are mindful of those in need. We are working together. So many are helping, giving and sharing. And with the tender compassion and care of the Lord, we will create a kinder world as we extend good food and the care of Christ to those most in need in our community and region. God will bless our efforts. And I pray every day that God will bless YOU.
- ...As we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King, we invite all those advancing in years or struggling with health to celebrate **the Sacrament of the Sick.** It is the most tender gesture to communicate the tender love and outpouring of God's mercy upon those in need. **We will anoint after each of the weekend Masses.** If you are reading this online, please invite your family, neighbors and friends to join you for Mass and Anointing. May you know the care that Christ the King has for you in every moment of your need.
- ...A few weeks ago, we were blessed to host a Healing Retreat. The other day I receive an email from the coordinator for the retreat sharing stories of how God worked in the lives of those who attended and how they found the healing grace of the Lord. Some were spiritual healings, while others were physical healing. Christ the King comes to care for each of us.

- ...This weekend, Friar Johnpaul will be helping with the Anointing and some of our Masses. He's actually helping so I can go and be a part of a Thanksgiving Food Distribution in Cleveland. Please welcome him. He will be leading the Lent Mission at Saint Ambrose.
- ...Many have been asking about Father Carlin and when he might arrive at Saint Ambrose. So here's the update. Father Carlin turned 75 years old a few weeks ago....Happy Birthday. Once the Diocese outlines a plan of who may replace him at Saint Charles, he will then have a timeline for coming to be a part of Saint Ambrose. May God bless him as we look forward to his presence and ministry back 'home' at Saint Ambrose.
- ...The signs of Advent and soon Christmas are starting to appear all over the campus. Coming to your home this week is your Advent Newsletter filled with great information and wonderful opportunities for all of us to use the four weeks of Advent to journey closer to the Lord and strengthen the bonds of faith, family and community. 




Liturgy Corner
