PARISH NEWS • Letter from Our Pastor

..."Brothers and sisters: Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near. Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." The second reading on this Gaudete Sunday - this Sunday of Joy and Rejoicing - is from Paul's letter to the Philippians. It's a powerful proclamation that our hope is in the Lord. The Lord is near, or as we would say this year at Saint Ambrose, God is with us, wherever we GO. In these final weeks of Advent bring your needs, your anxieties, your hopes and fears to the Lord. His peace will calm your mind and heart.

...As we approach the Joy of Christmas, our planning needs to be such that it stirs our hearts with great joy and peace. If you find yourself stretched or stressed, take some time to sit quietly with the Lord in prayer. Read this scripture passage over and again to yourself. Listen to some peaceful music (download the Saint Ambrose Spotify List). Stop by the Church or Chapel for some prayer and reflection. In other words, take the time to Go to Bethlehem....Go to a place of gentle peace with the Lord.

...This time of year is actually very difficult for so many people. Over the past few days, I've met with some of our members going through the challenges of the holiday season. We are so blessed as a parish to have about 50 trained Stephen Ministers. They are people who can help walk with you and offer support through difficult times in your life. **Feel free to call or email if you are struggling** (FrBob@ StAmbrose.us). ....I had a funny moment on Tuesday morning. I started my day by reading and finding this scripture passage and then entered into a busy morning. At one point I was meeting with our Business Office and a few members of our Parish Finance Council to review school tuition for next year. And then I got a call from Ed Plaspohl. He said, you have to come over to the Hall right away and see what's going on. Long story short, we were sorting and bagging food for Cleveland at a different time than usual and the Hall was packed with 60+ people doing the work of the Lord....taking care of those in need. walked back into the meeting and I was smiling from ear to ear and I said to them, "We have so many reasons to rejoice here at Saint Ambrose. We have the BEST members and together we are doing such great work for the Lord." And then I went on to spit off 10 more examples from the past few days when you can see the goodness of our parish. Praise be to God.

...More examples: Shari Whisler called on Sunday morning to share with me that EVERY tag was taken off the Advent giving trees last Sunday by the noon Mass. The Breakfast with Santa brought about 1,000 people (lots of young children) together for a great breakfast, crafts and activities and more. Four new people signed up last week to help with our Building and Grounds volunteers. Last Saturday's Advent VBS for 125 of our young members was wonderful...simply wonderful. To watch our young children learn the

Christmas story and reinforce that Jesus is the Reason for the Season...priceless. Another blessing was the GREAT attendance for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. And on and on and on. **On this Sunday of Joy and Rejoicing, I give praise and thanks to God for you.**

...And more...watching the legion of our members preparing and setting up all the details for the 12 Days of Christmas where 100+ of our members will receive random acts of kindness to remind them that they are not alone during these Christmas days was wonderful. Another crew was putting together nice touches and delivering plants and kindness to families who have members serving in the military through our Military Matters Ministry. And WE received several Christmas cards from people across the United States offering Christmas thanks for those who serve in our Mass Streaming Ministry. They so greatly appreciate the ability to pray with us from across the country. We are blessed. We as a community of faith have every reason to rejoice and be glad!!!

...Your 2025 Parish Calendar will be here next weekend. God bless Rebecca and Hannah for all their work to create a calendar that is inspiring and shares the good news of our community. We are ramping up for a blessed 2025 at Saint Ambrose!!!

Liturgy Corner Not Far from Bethlehem

When we think of Christmas, we often think of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem, the city of David in which Jesus was born. How long would it have taken to travel from Nazareth to Bethlehem? Ideally, a person on foot can perhaps travel about twenty miles a day. However, given Mary's condition, they would have traveled much less. This means their journey likely took place over a ten-day period. The hazards were many - wild animals, bandits, desert robbers, the weather. All these and more contributed to the hardship of the trip. For food, Mary and Joseph had bread, herbs and oil, and maybe some dried fish. Water would need to be

carried, perhaps in wineskins. Mary and Joseph endured all this and trusted in God.

Mary and Joseph arrived in Bethlehem, a name which means "house of bread". It is fitting that the Child Jesus is born there, as He is the Bread of Life who gives himself as food for eternal life.


