Mary set out and traveled

to the hill country in haste to a town of Judah, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy. Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

...The Gospel on the Fourth Sunday of Advent offers us also a powerful and prayerful reflection as we celebrate the Feast of Christmas. Mary and Joseph had a radical openness to the Lord. As the Lord sent them out on a journey, it was the Lord that was their faithful companion and guide. The Lord entrusted to them the most important work, as Mary reflected on the faithfulness of God, both in visiting Elizabeth and then journeying with Joseph to Bethlehem. She was overwhelmed by the faithfulness of God. Her example and witness reminds us that we need to place our trust in the Lord. God is faithful to His promises. God is faithful and deserving of our **trust.** He is trustworthy!!! "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

...This week's bulletin is both for the Fourth Sunday of Advent and for Christmas. It is filled with wonderful information and opportunities for you and our parish community to celebrate the joy of Christmas, to strengthen our trust in the Lord, and walk into the New Year renewed and recommitted to growing in our relationship with the Lord through prayer and service. Take some time to take a good look through the bulletin.

...The theme for our Christmas Season is from the timeless Christmas song, "Go Tell it on the Mountain." Like Elizabeth and Mary we need to tell everyone about the mighty things God has done and is doing in our lives. From taking care of 135 families with Christmas food and gifts, to our community meal last Sunday that provided a homemade roast beef dinner to almost 600 people, to the great work they do each week to care of 85-110 families through our food pantry, and so much more. We are so blessed by their faithful service to the Lord and our community.

...God bless all who help support our Prayer and Worship. From the beautifully decorated church -to the inspiring music - to the warm greeting at the doors of the Church...we are blessed by their ministry and service. We are so blessed!!!

...Next weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. Think about your family Christmas celebrations. Faith and Family go hand in hand. The Knights of Columbus are leading a special effort to help your family, and all of our families, rededicate our families to the Lord. Families set upon the Lord are like the house set on rock. 

New Series Beginning Wednesday, January 8


